




- **4. DEPOSIT UPON ACCEPTANCE:** If you are offered acceptance, please be prepared to pay a deposit of 15,600 RMB (per child) to save the space that has been offered. The deposit is **nonrefundable** and must be paid within 10 working days of the issue of the acceptance letter. The amount is applied to tuition; it is NOT an additional fee.


*Acceptable forms of passports / ID cards:

Foreign nationality provide a copy of passport photo page and the valid Chinese visa page

Macau or Hong Kong provide a front and back copy of Mainland Travel Permit for Hong Kong and Macao residents, HK/Macau ID card and Passport.

Taiwan –provide a photo page copy of the Mainland Travel Permit for Taiwan Residents and the permission to stay page.

China – provide a front and back copy of Chinese ID card (only parents may have Chinese ID cards; students cannot use a Chinese ID card)
